This scholarship enables each teenage orphan girl to complete at least a secondary, general or technical education that will lead to financial and economic autonomy, greatly reducing the risk of being infected with HIV through sexual abuse and violence.

At the United Nations World Summit on Sustainable Development meeting on September 25, 2015 more than 150 world leaders adopted the now 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, including the <u>Sustainable Development Goals</u>. The 17 new Sustainable Development Goals, also known as Global Goals are:

Goal 1: No poverty; Goal 2: Zero hunger; Goal 3: Good health and well-being; Goal 4: Quality education; Goal 5: Gender equality; Goal 6: Clean water and sanitation; Goal 7: Affordable and clean energy; Goal 8: Decent work and economic growth; Goal 9: Industry, innovation, infrastructure; Goal 10: Reduces inequalities; Goal 11: Sustainable cities and communities; Goal 12: Responsible consumption, production; Goal 13: Climate action; Goal 14: Life below water; Goal 15: Life on land; Goal 16: Peace, justice and strong institutions; Goal 17: Partnerships for the goals.

From the large debate that took place, Civil Society participants would like to draw your attention on the following key points:

**UN Secretary- General Ban Ki-moon"...**The 2030 Agenda is for you, it is for everyone, everywhere. Claim it, demand that commitments are made and promises kept. Be part of the global call to action.

Angela Merkel, Chancelor of Germany: "...
